Only amounts incurred for Covered Health Care Services that are subject to the Deductible will count toward the Deductible. The Deductible applies to the Annual Out-of-Pocket Limit. Co-payments for certain types of Covered Health Care Services do not apply toward the Out-of-Pocket Limit and will require a Co-payment even after the Out-of-Pocket Limit has been met. The Annual Out-of-Pocket Limit includes Co-payments for UnitedHealthcare benefits including behavioral health, and prescription drug benefits. It does not include standalone, separate and independent Dental, Vision and Chiropractic benefit plans offered to groups. When an individual member of a family unit has paid an amount of Deductible and Co-payments for the Calendar Year equal to the Individual Out-of-Pocket Limit, no further Co-payments will be due for Covered Health Care Services for the remainder of that Calendar Year.
